

St. John's Circle of Care Foundation Scholarship

The Scholarships (3 - \$500) will be awarded to individuals who are presently employed at St. John's Circle of Care AND a current year high school graduate OR currently attending, or planning to attend, a formal year long program study.

This application must be received by the St. John's Circle of Care- Front Desk on or before April 12th, 2024.

- Applicant must show evidence of scholastic achievement of at least 2.5 high school or accredited school grade point average OR show evidence of potential scholastic success based on employment evaluations.
- Applicant will meet with Scholarship committee and/or Board of Directors prior to the final selection.
- Applicant should be aware that the Scholarship Committee will gather additional subjective data to evaluate leadership, loyalty, citizenship, initiative, attitudes, ideals and responsibility.
- Applicant is to include statement of goals and plans for the future. This is not an "essay contest" but rather is meant to give an opportunity to show who you are and what you hope to be.

There are no restrictions as to race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, disability, age marital status, or status with regard to public assistance or sexual preference.

- Awards will be based on three criteria:

1/3 of the overall rating will be based on hours of service at St. Johns Circle of Care.

1/3 of the overall rating will be based on an interview.

1/3 of the overall rating will be based on application information.
